ABOUT JSP... Hodgson Elkington LLP launched the Junior Sports Programme in 2006 to help encourage the development of junior sporting activities in Lincolnshire and East Nottinghamshire.

The programme was originally funded by the partnership which set aside an annual budget to provide equipment, trophies, medals and other forms of sponsorship for local teams involved in a wide range of sporting activities.

The Junior Sports Programme was incorporated in 2008 as the Junior Sports Programme Trust Ltd which gained charitable status (registered charity number 1126453) in 2009.

The members of Hodgson Elkington LLP continue to provide core funding for the Trust's activities but are now helped with financial support from many local corporate and private donors who have contributed generously to help the Trust increase the amount of support that it is able to provide.

Over 70 local clubs and schools are now involved in the Junior Sports Programme.

Angling

Junior Sports Programme were again sponsors of the Salmon & Trout Association annual casting competition at the Lincolnshire Show in June. The winning school, Thorpe on the Hill, received the Junior Sports Programme trophy. Plans for 2011 include development of a coaching scheme for junior fly fishers.

Badminton

Individual assistance has been provided to Hanley Towlar with a contribution towards travel costs so that he can represent the county in tournaments.

Basketball

The Gold Award Scheme was introduced at Newark and won by members of Newark Tournados Basketball Club.

Cricket

Junior Sports Programme has been able to provide St Peter & St Paul's School with assistance for the purchase of match balls for the season. Bingham Cricket Club have been helped to provide equipment for their newly-formed girls' cricket team.

Football

The Junior Sports Programme managed to dramatically increase its involvement in football during 2010.



The Fair Play Award has been introduced to Collingham Football Club's Under 12s Boys Team, the Greenbank Football Club Junior Tournament and Birchwood Colts.

Junior Sports Programme medals and contributions towards trophies were provided for these clubs and also Ruskington Lions and Lincoln Griffins Girls' Football Team.

Equipment or contributions towards equipment were provided for Waddington Football Club Under 18s, Rushton Sports Club, HBW United, Cherry Willingham Under 8s and the Lincoln Griffins Girls' Football Team.

Gymnastics

For a second year, the Junior Sports Programme was able to assist Lincoln Gymnastics Club with a contribution towards the cost of trophies for their annual tournament.

Tri-Golf

Two sets of loan equipment were introduced by the Junior Sports Programme in 2009 for use by the Cherry Willingham Sports Partnership. The scheme has been successful and in 2010 Tri-Gold tournaments were held for the William Farr family of schools in Lincoln and the Princess Elizabeth family of schools in Gainsborough.

Hockey

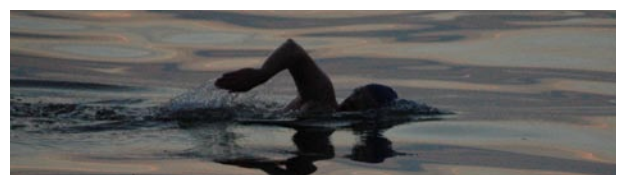
Fair Play Awards were presented at Newark Otters & Beavers awards evening. The Junior Sports Programme was also able to assist Lincoln Hockey Club with a contribution towards the cost of new junior playing kit.

Pop Lacrosse

Junior Sports Programme loan equipment is now in use in schools throughout Lincolnshire and East Nottinghamshire. In addition to equipment, the Junior Sports Programme has also helped with the organisation of local and regional tournaments in Bingham, Newark and Stamford. The Hodgson Elkington trophy was awarded to St Peter's Church of England school in East Bridgford who went on to compete in the national final.

Swimming

We have continued our support for Lincoln Vulcan Swimming Club and Lincoln Pentagua Swimming Club. Pupils from St George's, Sleaford, North Kesteven High School, Sleaford and Welton High School, Grantham were presented with gold awards in recognition of their participation in the English Channel relay swim. We were also able to contribute towards the cost of organising the event.

Tennis

The Junior Sports Programme has again been able to sponsor Heighington Tennis Club's annual tournament in September and make a contribution towards the cost of junior equipment. We hope to encourage more junior tennis clubs to participate in 2011.

Ultimate

Six teams took part in the Lincolnshire Schools Ultimate Frisbee Championship in July. Junior Sports Programme provided frisbees for the participants in a game which is described as a cross-between American football and netball. The Junior Sports Programme expects to increase its involvement in this discipline during 2011.

Judo

The Junior Sports Programme was able to help in 2010 with assistance towards trophies for the county championship tournament.

Wind-surfing

Emma Lamborne was helped during the year with a contribution towards her competition travel costs.

Fair Play Award

The Junior Sports Programme Fair Play Award is now well-established as a feature of sporting activities in many schools and clubs. Participants in 2010 included Collingham Football Club, Greenbank Football Club, Birchwood Colts, Lincoln Griffins Girls' Football Team, Newark Otters & Beavers, Lincoln Pentagua, Lincolnshire County Judo Championship and the Mount Church of England Junior School.

New Activities

The Junior Sports Programme contributed towards refreshments costs for the children participating at a new event for primary schools held at RAF Cranwell where pupils and teachers had an opportunity to participate in new sporting events. During 2011, the Junior Sports Programme will be encouraging the introduction of new sporting activities that children can enjoy using existing facilities in schools and clubs. This will involve the provision of additional loan equipment and the introduction of coaching and teacher training to help clubs and schools make full use of existing resources.

First Aid Training

The first of a series of First Aid training courses was organised in November at the North Kesteven Sports Centre. The courses, which are fully-funded by the Junior Sports Programme, provide essential certificated First Aid training for coaches and supervisors. The first event was over-subscribed and a further course is now planned for 2011. It is hoped to make this a regular part of the Junior Sports Programme.

'Award Schemes'...

The first Fair Play Award was sponsored by Hodgson Elkington in 2007 and allocated to Newark Otters & Beavers Hockey Club.

The concept has now been developed more fully and is offered to all clubs participating in the programme which wish to reward 'Fair Play'.

The administrators of individual clubs are left to determine who they nominate for the award and in what particular age group. The award can be made to an individual or to a group.

The Trust provides a Salver for the winner, together with a package of equipment to assist in scoring and adjudication.

New for 2010 is the Junior Sports Programme 'GOLD AWARD'

These specially commissioned medals will be awarded to individuals for extraordinary *achievement* or *contribution* to junior sport.

Eligibility

All junior members of participating clubs are eligible for nomination to receive the award for '**achievement**'. The award for '**contribution**' is open to junior members and adults providing voluntary assistance in the coaching and administration of junior sport activities.

Participation

Clubs wishing to participate in the 'GOLD AWARD' scheme are provided with an information pack and nomination forms. Participants are eligible for one award per annum in each category.

Nominations

Nominations can be made at any time during the relevant sporting season and up to one month prior to the date of the award. Awards will be made at the end of May or at the end of November in each year dependent upon the sporting discipline and individual club preferences.

The Junior Sports Programme 'GOLD AWARD' is a small but significant recognition of their efforts.
